



NOTICE OF RACE OCTOBER 24, 25, & 26, 2008

INVITED SATURDAY: Alerion 28, Beneteau 36.7, Cal 20, Express 27 & 37, ID35, J24, J105, J109, Melges 24, Moore 24, Olson 30, Santana 20 & 22, SF 30, Ultimate 20 & 24, Wylie Wabbit, 99er's, and any boats with PHRF handicaps. Each class, invited explicitly or not, with 5 or more boats will be given its own start. Classes with 3 or more boats will be scored as a class. Other boats will be put into PHRF divisions.

INVITED SUNDAY: Open to all boats with a PHRF or BAMA Certificate.

(New this year – PHRF boats on Saturday, BAMA boats on Sunday)

REGISTER AND PAY ENTRY FEE ONLINE

ENTRY FEE: \$1/foot to race Sat. - \$1/foot to race Sun. - \$2/foot to race both days. Pay by Monday, October 20th (6pm) or be subject to a LATE FEE of \$25. The S.I.'s and a permit for parking on the club grounds will be mailed to sailors whose entries are received by October 12th. Credit cards accepted for online registration.

NO ENTRIES accepted after Thursday, October 23rd (6pm).

SATURDAY RACING: One Design and PHRF classes will be run on three courses in the Southampton Olympic Circle and Slot Areas. Each course will have separate start and

finish lines. The first race, on each course, will start at 11:30 AM. Each class, invited explicitly or not, with 5 or more boats will be given its own start. Classes with 3 or more boats will be scored as a class. Other boats will be put into PHRF divisions.

SUNDAY PURSUIT RACE: Open to all invited classes and boats with a PHRF or BAMA certificate. Will be around Angel Island and Alcatraz. The slowest Rated boat (handicap 264) will start at 12:00 noon. In the interest of fun and family racing, spinnaker rated boats sailing without a spinnaker have a 10 second per mile allowance, i.e., rating increase by 10.
