There will be a start for each one- design class or PHRF fleet with 5 or more boats. The Race committee may establish two separate racing areas to minimize the interactions of fleets.
- Racing Sunday:** Sunday's race will be one reverse-handicap long-distance race within the bay, starting in the Southampton area and finishing off the RYC breakwater.
