Harbor Rules for Guests and Cruise Ins

- Before arriving, all visiting yachts must check in with the harbormaster by phone or email for a berthing assignment.
- Visitor berthing is available on a first come first serve basis dependent upon club activities.
- All yachts visiting Richmond Yacht Club must identify themselves by flying their yacht club burgee.
- After you have secured your boat, present your current yacht club affiliation card to the Harbormaster and complete RYC Visitor agreement.
- RYC allows for 3 nights reciprocal privileges for visiting yacht club members. Additional nights, if available, will be billed at non-member slip rental rates.
- The Guest berthing is for temporary use with a maximum of 30 days allowed per calendar year for members; 10 days for non-members.
- Guests are not permitted to operate generators or perform boat maintenance while on RYC's docks, unless specific permission has been granted.
- Please tie up as far in the slips or end ties as possible to allow room for other arriving boats.
- Boats will be given warning and shall move from the docks one day prior to major club functions and regattas.
- Failure to do so may result in a fine. Docking plans must be adhered to at all times unless otherwise permitted.
- Dogs shall be on leash and under the control of owner while off the boat.
- Charcoal BBQs are not allowed in the harbor, BBQs are not allowed on the docks. Gas BBQs must be attached to the boat and a fire extinguisher must be within 10 feet while operating the BBQ.
